CSV, THE DRIVING FORCE IN THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

Improving the quality of life for its citizens and adapting the community to current circumstances have been the main focuses of the CSV officials during the current parliamentary term.

Under the leadership of our mayor, Marion Zovilé, and our councillor, Tom Jungblut, supported by the three council members, Jim Schmitz, Jean-Pierre Di Genova, and Yves Loose (formerly Laurent Lakaff), they have been advancing the plans for future major projects.

The well-being, safety, and general services are fundamental aspects of our policies. At CSV Contern, we place the residents at the heart of our efforts. That's why we have undertaken numerous projects to meet the needs of our growing community and promote the quality of life.

FAMILY, SCHOOL, YOUTH, SENIOR CITIZENS:

- The „safe school route“ has been developed.
- Solar benches have been installed for charging mobile phones.
- Every year, the municipality, in collaboration with the school in Contern, organizes a major event to clean up

the forests, roads, and paths from litter.



- Pétanque courts, football pitches, playgrounds, and parks have been renovated and newly created in all areas of the community.
- A new multi-sports field has been established in Moutfort Park.

SAFETY & SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY:

- The police regulations have been revised.
- A 30 km/h speed zone will soon be implemented in the village center of Contern. The sewerage, gas, water, and fiber optic works have been completed, making this project nearly finished.
- A parking regulation (resident parking) has been introduced, and a parking attendant has been hired.

- Traffic calming measures are currently being implemented in the four villages of the community.
- Security cameras are being installed.
- The concept of the Contibus has been revised, and a Night Rider service has been introduced.

HEALTH, SPORTS, CULTURE, RECREATION, COMMUNITY LIFE:

- At the insistence of the responsible politicians, our community has been granted a pharmacy (November 2022).
- 4 rooms for community activities and a new rehearsal space for the church choir „Les Villageois“ have been created in the „Henkeshaus.“
- The Trim-Dich course in Medingen has been completely renovated with new equipment.
- An outdoor fitness area has been established.

- Book cabinets have been installed in various villages.
- The bicycle path between Contern and Itzig remains a construction site yet to be completed.
- For the first time, a Christmas market (in Moutfort) has been organized by the initiative of the municipality.

INTEGRATION

- The municipality regularly organizes a „Potercafé,“ aimed at enhancing integration and fostering community cohesion while providing an opportunity to learn a new language.
- The offerings for Luxembourgish language courses have been improved and continue to be well-attended.
- Upon the initiative of our elected representatives and their daily efforts on the ground, a distribution center for goods and clothing has been established, providing assistance to up to 1,000 Ukrainian people fleeing their homes each day. Additionally, 140 Ukrainian refugees have been accommodated at the cultural center in Moutfort.
- For the first time, a welcome brochure for new residents of the community has been developed and distributed during a warm-hearted reception.

AGRICULTURE & NATURE CONSERVATION:

- The acquisition of a hoeing machine and harrow enables us to ensure clean drinking water. Herbicides are avoided on a significant portion of the cornfields in the municipality of Contern. These modern camera-guided



machines allow mechanical weed control in corn crops, similar to hoeing in a home garden. The use of pesticides is reduced, providing tangible water protection. This pioneering spirit pays off in terms of our drinking water and the environment.

- The municipality of Contern has joined the Nature Pact, committing to promote biodiversity at the community level.
- A biotope with two ponds has been created in Oetringen.
- A „Kannerbongert“ (children’s orchard) has been established in Oetringen, where an annual tradition invol-

ves planting fruit trees and hedges for newborns.



EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES, DEMOCRACY, CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT, AND INFORMATION POLICY:

- Public meetings have been organized for major projects or issues, such as the development of new village centres for Contern and Moutfort, urban planning, renovation of the „Conter Stuff,“ affordable housing, resident parking, and more.
- An app called „GemengContern“ has been introduced, along with the overhaul of the municipality’s website.
- The „Commune of Contern“ institution has embraced a new visual identity.

ENVIRONMENT, ENERGY, AND CLIMATE PROTECTION:



- The CSV considers the installation of photovoltaic systems as one of the solutions in the discussion on climate change. Under the impetus of the CSV, two systems were installed in Moutfort on the cultural center (28.5 kWp) in 2004 and on the new sports hall (29.9 kWp) in Contern in 2009.
- In 2019, a 152 kWp system was installed on the pre-school building in Contern. Additionally, there is a 15 kWp photovoltaic system on the roof of the municipal building.
- At the urging of our elected representatives, the largest photovoltaic systems in Luxembourg were installed on the roofs of two larger halls in the Weiergewan industrial zone in 2021, covering an area of 7 hectares.
- The Climate Pact 2.0 obliges the municipality of Contern to consistently and continuously implement measures for climate protection.

- A solar cadastre has been developed, which is an online tool that provides information about the solar potential of your property. You can find the solar cadastre at: www.cadastre-solaire.contern.lu
- The lighting in the municipality is gradually being converted to energy-efficient LED technology.
- The municipality of Contern has introduced the „weighing principle“ for waste disposal, leading to a reduction of over 600 tonnes of waste produc-



tion.

- Recently, a financial support scheme has been introduced for our residents, encouraging the installation of solar or photovoltaic systems, promoting heating measures that utilize renewable energy, and supporting energy-saving initiatives.

URBAN PLANNING, INFRASTRUCTURE, HOUSING:

- The second phase of renovation works on the „Henkeshaus“ in Contern has been completed.
- The sports club „Aurore“ has received a grandstand in their gymnasium.
- In the Centre Culturel in Moutfort, along with the complete renovation of the main banquet hall, a professional kitchen has been installed in the garage.
- Water and electricity distribution points have been installed in Moutfort Park to facilitate cultural events in our community.



- Parking facilities at various cultural centers have been expanded. For example, 30 additional parking spaces have been created at the Oetringen cultural center, „am Medenpoull.“ Care was taken to avoid further sealing of the ground.
- Parking availability in the center of Contern has also been expanded wit-

hout additional ground sealing.

- The pipeline system in Contern has been renewed. In the 1970s, the construction of a regional wastewater treatment plant in Übersyren began. The modernization of this pipeline system, along with the investment in a rainwater separation system that will ultimately relieve the treatment plant, reduces its impact on the environment.
- We have established a retention basin system to mitigate the increasingly frequent heavy rainfall due to climate change. After years of construction work, a connected water retention system will soon be in place. Additional retention basins in Oetringen, Contern, Milbëch, and Moutfort will be



built or completed in the future.

- Traffic calming measures, such as narrowing of roads, higher curbs, compliant bus stops, and the installation of high red „cushions“ on the streets, are gradually being implemented in our 4 villages.
- We have made the field paths safer for pedestrians and cyclists by restricting them from through traffic.



- Our elected representatives were keen to ensure that our municipality contributes to the issue of „affordable housing“ as quickly as possible. Two new projects will soon be developed in Contern and Oetringen. The „Contern Sud“ project is already in the implementation phase, with 5 houses

already sold under a land lease contract, and 23 plots being sold through a scoring system.

FINANCE & ECONOMY

- During the current legislative period, the municipality of Contern has not taken on any additional loans. The outstanding loans amounting to 12.5 million euros as of the end of 2022 provide the future political leaders with the necessary flexibility to position our community in a forward-looking manner.
